SPORTS NEWS.

THE FIFTH TEST MATCH IN AUSTRALIA HAS ENDED IN A DRAW. THIS MEANS THAT AUSTRALIA RETAINS THE ASHES. SCORES AT THE CLOSE OF PLAY IN THE LAST TEST WERE AS FOLLOWS.

ENGLAND : (First Innings) 485 for 9 Declared.

AUSTRALIA : (First Innings) 533 for 8 Declared.

At the close of play England were 69 for 3 in their second innings.

BOXING. A QUICK WIN FOR THE BRITISH AND EMPIRE HEAVYWEIGHT CHAMPION HENRY COOPER. HE KNOCKED OUT JEFFERSON DAVIES OF THE UNITED STATES IN 1 MINUTE 40 SECONDS AT WOLVERHAMPTON TODAY. THIS IS THE QUICKEST VICTORY IN COOPERS CAREER. DAVIS HAS NEVER BEEN KNOCKED OUT BEFORE.

WORLD NEWS.

THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF WEST GERMANY'S CHRISTIAN DEMOCRAT PARTY HAVE RECOMMENDED THAT CHANCELLOR ERHARD SUCCEED DR. ARDANAR AS CHAIRMAN.

THE DEFENCE MINISTERS OF BRITAIN, WEST GERMANY, ITALY, AND TURKEY ARE ON THEIR WAY TO WASHINGTON TO TALK TO THE AMERICANS ABOUT NATO NUCLEAR PLANNING. THIS IS THE FIRST OF A SERIES OF MEETINGS TO IMPROVE NUCLEAR CONSULTATIONS BETWEEN NATO COUNTRIES. THE MAIN QUESTION IS HOW TO SATISFY WEST GERMANY'S DEMANDS FOR A SAY IN PLANNING. THE BRITISH DEFENCE MINISTER, MR HEALEY, SAID THAT HE IS GOING TO WASHINGTON FOR THE NATO TALKS AND NOT TO BUY AMERICAN F-111 BOMBERS.

A BRITISH GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN HAS SAID THAT THE AMOUNT OF OIL GETTING INTO RHODESIA IS NEGLIGABLE. A JOHANNESBURG NEWSPAPER YESTERDAY SAID YESTERDAY THAT APPROX. 35,000 GALLONS WAS GETTING IN ONE TO-GETHER WITH A SIMILAR AMOUNT FROM MOZAMBIQUE. A BRITISH ESTIMATES RANGE FROM 4,000 TO 8,000 GALLONS - FAR LOWER THAN RHODESIA'S CONSUMPTION, EVEN WITH THE RATIONING NOW IN FORCE.

THE HOUSE OF LORDS HAS APPROVED A BRITISH GOVERNMENT ORDER WHICH TIGHTENED THE ECONOMIC SANCTIONS AGAINST RHODESIA AT THE END OF LAST MONTH. THE ORDER WHICH PROHIBITS VIRTUALLY ALL TRADE WITH RHODESIA WAS APPROVED WITHOUT A VOTE.

The queen and the duke of Edinburgh are continuing their Caribbean cruise and are now at the island of St. Lucia.
